- Footnotes: Utilize footnotes instead of endnotes and adhere to the Bluebook (20th Edition) Style of Footnoting.
- 7. **Peer Review Process:** All submitted papers will go through a rigorous peer review process to ensure quality and academic integrity.
- 8. Co-authorship: Co-authorship is permitted, limited to one co-author per submission. Both authors must pay the registration fees.
- 9. **Registration Fees:** A non-refundable registration fee of Rs. 500 per author is applicable.
